

## LEAGUE SECRETARY

  - c. Preparation of Agendas for such meetings.
6. The Handbook Secretary (Graham Hyde) will also be responsible for compiling the Averages for 2008 Season and onwards.

Although there is a certain amount of work involved, it's great fun and would be the perfect way for someone who has been actively involved in Nidderdale cricket to continue their association with the league and thus keep in touch with old friends and adversaries, as well as keeping abreast of developments in the game locally.
8. It is important that plans are in place as soon as possible to find a NEW league Secretary to take up the post in one year's time and applications are invited forthwith.
9. Tricia has indicated her willingness to remain available for consultation, tea and sympathy, indefinitely!
